## Message from the Deputy and Head

It has been a busy and fun week in school with our Keeping Healthy Days. We hope your children enjoyed their trip to the Cookery School and the A-Life Workshop in school, and you all had a fun time at Sports Day. Many thanks to all the staff for going the extra mile this week to support all these extra activities, and to FOKS for contributing so much towards the funding of them. We hope that as well as having a good time, your child has learnt some important things about how to keep themselves healthy and happy both now and in the future.

It was a pleasure to welcome the entire Executive Team from Acorn into school last week for our annual Quality Assurance visit. We were particularly pleased that in amongst the many strengths they identified was our culture and ethos, the relationships between children and staff and how this leads to great team-work across the school, the behaviour of the children, and the calm learning atmosphere. They were also complimentary about the teaching and learning taking place across the school, and have given us helpful pointers as to how we can improve this in the future. This will feed into our School Improvement Plan that we are beginning to write for next year, and we will share this with you once it is complete.

You will hopefully have spotted on our new Behaviour Management System that we shared in the last newsletter, the emphasis that we place on developing independence in our children. This is a key skill for learning and life, that will serve children well during their time with us and beyond. To help facilitate the children growing in this area, we would like to strongly encourage parents from Year 2 upwards (so Spring Class and above) to let their children come in and sort themselves out, independently every morning. Ideally we would ask you to say goodbye to your children at the front gate or door. But we understand that sometimes you may need to speak to a member of staff from your child's class first thing in the morning. So to enable this, the class teacher or TA will stand at the classroom door from 8:45am, to take messages etc. without you having to go into the room, thus still leaving the children to organize themselves independently. We appreciate your support in helping your children to develop in this way.
