I mentioned last week that the Acorn Education Trust are starting an appeal to raise money that can be accessed by families within their schools who have been adversely affected by Covid-19 to help children be ready to return to school in September. We are still awaiting the next round of Government guidance concerning what they will be asking of schools in September. Many stories and ideas and rumours are currently abounding in the media... It would seem at the moment that the most likely outcome (although that could have changed between the time of my writing this and the letter being sent out!) will be that we are asked to operate the school on a similar model and timetable to the one we are following at the moment, but we will be allowed to increase group sizes to encompass whole classes. This would mean that every child could be in school every day, and teaching and learning could re-start properly. As soon as I know and am able to plan accordingly, I will let you know. Please remember that we are waiting on this before confirming when our TD Days will be next year and what induction programme we will be offering for our new YR children, amongst many other important things. I am hugely grateful for your patience and understanding with all of this uncertainty.

All of us in school are very much looking forward to welcoming so many more children back next week. We know that time in school is very limited for some year groups, and we are very sorry that we are not able to offer more. But hopefully a few days with their friends and doing some different activities will provide a real boost for everyone's wellbeing. I certainly know that the staff feel that sharing the children's joy and excitement on their return is a priceless gift.
