Message from the Deputy and Head

We are aware that many of you are working very hard at the moment in preparation for the forthcoming Scarecrow Trail, and we would like to take the opportunity to say a very big thank you to you for all your hard work. You raise a phenomenal amount of money which enables us to do so many things that enrich the lives and experiences of our children. This year FOKS has funded: a budget for each class which is used to pay for visitors, trips and equipment for the children; an extra trip for each class, Autumn Class went to the Bath University Science Fair, Summer Class to the Bath Children's Literature Festival, and we are in the process of organizing theatre trips for Spring and Winter Classes; all of the equipment that is used in Forest School; a large contribution towards our recent IT over-haul. We are also about to embark on a large project to improve the playground, a significant proportion of which is being funded by FOKS. Over the up-coming half term holiday we will be having new, bespoke storage built in the playground. Then in the summer holiday we will be re-surfacing half of the playground with play turf, creating a basketball area, and installing a retractable awning. In the next academic year we will also be working with the children to decide what new playground equipment they would like to extend their play opportunities.

All in all this has a huge impact on the children's learning, development and enjoyment of school, and are things that we would wish to do but would not be able to without your support. So on behalf of all the staff and children, thank you very very much.

Medicines in School
