Message from the Head

Earlier this year we raised a significant amount of money to help towards the Church's building appeal, through the sponsored events that each class ran and a generous donation from FOKS following the Scarecrow Trail. As well as wanting to contribute as part of the community in the village and through our strong links with St Leonard's, we explained at the time how the school and children will directly benefit from the proposed adaptations to the Church. As a flexible open area will be created at the back of the nave, which we are being welcomed to use as an alternative learning space. Plus of course, the addition of a toilet!

The building work is all set to start on 6th January 2020, and it is hoped that it will be completed within 12 weeks which takes us to 20th March. There will be some disruption during this period which will impact on all of us who form the school community. In particular we are being asked to ensure that **no cars park in or drive down School Close**, **or use the entrance of the road as a turning point** during this time. We understand that this will cause additional complexity at drop off and pick up times. But we ask for your understanding and support, in order to keep all members of our community safe and enable the work to take place as efficiently as possible in the Church.

In order to help with this, we would suggest the following things:

- If you need to turn around in the village, use the end of Martins Road at the stocks as a safe place to do this.
- Consider a 'one-way' route through the village during this time.
- Make use of the bus as much as possible for those families who live in Bulkington, Great Hinton and Steeple Ashton.
- Lift share if you have to use a car to get your child to and from school.
- Use the 'rolling drop' run by Mrs James in the morning to prevent the need for parking.
- Keep your time at school before and after drop off and pick up times to a minimum.

We understand that this will mean that there will be more cars parking along Main Street during this time. We are being asked to continue to keep the stretch of road in front of the school clear to maintain a passing space for traffic, so we will keep putting out the cones every day. We appreciate you respecting this as a no parking zone. And we ask you to continue being considerate when parking in the village. We know that it will require extra patience from us all as we are inconvenienced by the disruption to our normal routines, and we are very grateful to you for this. It will be exciting when the work is all complete and the school can take advantage of the extra space we can use in the Church.

Uniform

Just a little reminder for children to be wearing the correct uniform in school every day – white polo shirt, school jumper/cardigan, grey trousers/skirt/shorts/pinafore, plain grey socks for boys, plain white or grey socks for girls, plain grey or red tights for girls, and black school shoes. Thank you for your support with this.

Parent Volunteers

We are wondering if anyone has a spare hour or two in an afternoon each week, and would like to spend that time hearing children read in school... It is incredibly beneficial for some children to read 1:1 with an adult as much as possible, and this is something that is very difficult for teachers and TAs to achieve in amongst everything else they need to do every day. If you are interested please let Mrs Hermon know. She is hoping to run a short training session in the new year for anyone who kindly offers to help, so if you are not sure that you feel confident in what would be required of you please don't let that put you off. Thank you very much.
