KEEVIL COPE ACADEMY COVID CONTINUITY PLAN

Aim

This document explains what will happen if we get confirmed Covid-19 cases within our community, and also what could happen if staffing numbers are significantly reduced due to the on-going pandemic. This forms Keevil's continuity plan.

Our principles:

- * Keeping all children and staff safe and well
- * Ensuring we deliver the best possible learning for all children at all times
- * Utilising staff in the most effective way possible



Acorn Education Trust principles:

- *Schools open and safe
- *Staff and students/children are happy and feel safe
- *Students/children are learning, teachers are teaching at school or at home



Person with symptoms and their household isolate for 14 days.

Bubble to isolate at home for 14 days.

<u>Positive case of Covid-19 confirmed in a bubble:</u>

DfE and Public Health England contacted by school

Rooms will be deep cleaned and disinfected.

Home learning will be set up and distributed via class pages on the school website.

Zoom sessions will be set up and invites for these will be sent out on the first day of the closure by the class teacher and/or class TA.

If class teachers and/or TAs are unwell virtual learning sessions will not be able to take place. Instead families will be signposted to learning resources that can be used with children at home.

In the event of staff members being absent from school for extended periods:

If we are unable to keep all classes open due to unsafe levels of staffing within the school, we will operate a weekly rotation of classes working in school. This could be:

Classes not in school will be offered home learning options through class pages on the school website.

Provision for Keyworker and Vulnerable children will be provided Mondays-Thursdays for classes not learning in school.

If staffing levels are severely depleted we will have to take the decision to close the entire school.

Home learning will be offered through class pages on the school website and Zoom sessions where possible.

Such decisions will only be taken when no other options are available, and to ensure the safety of children and staff at all times.
