Use of the Toilets

We completely understand that sometimes parents and pre-school children might need to use the facilities within the school. Due to safeguarding issues we would appreciate it if you use the STAFF toilets rather than the children's toilets. Thank you for your understanding.

Free School Meals/Pupil Premium

It has come to our attention that some children who could receive pupil premium via free school meals are not claiming what they are entitled to. In past years free school meals were available to children whose families are eligible to claim certain benefits. Of course at present all infants receive a universal free school meal. If your child would have been entitled to free school meals under the old system, because you are receiving qualifying benefits, the government will give your school a Pupil Premium of £1,320 for primary-aged pupils. This fund could then be used to help with additional costs such as school trips, residential visits etc.

For the school and your child to benefit from this money you need to make a claim through Wiltshire Council http://www.wiltshire.gov.uk/schools-learning-free-school-meals
